- Applications will be filled online by the candidates. Incomplete applications will be rejected. Detailed instructions to fill the same are available on <http://www.apprenticeshipindia.org>.
- Only online registered applications will be accepted.
- The examination is valid for one entry only.
- Following are to be uploaded as the case may be:
 - Class 10/ Matriculation passing certificate
 - Intermediate/10+2 or equivalent mark sheet, ITI pass Certificate.
 - Passport size recent colour photograph of size not larger than 50 KB in front portrait with light background without head gear, except for Sikhs. The photograph is to be taken with the candidate holding a black slate in front of his chest with his/her name clearly written on it in capital letters with white chalk.
 - Candidates signature image.
 - Candidate's left hand thumb impression.
- A written examination will be conducted based on Mathematics, General Science & General Knowledge of High School standard. In addition, On Job Testing on respective trades would be conducted as a part of selection procedure.
- Candidate must have his valid e-mail and mobile number for Successful online registration.
- Candidate must endorse his/her Aadhar number while registration on RDSDE portal.
- The candidate is to carry a valid ID proof and printout of provisional admit card, when reporting for selection test.
- Candidates shall be debarred from appearing in the written exam, in case anomalies/ irregularities/ incorrect information are observed during initial verification at the examination venue or at any subsequent stage of the selection process.
- The Selection for engagement of the Apprentice will be based on Merit, taking into consideration the total aggregate marks scored in the selection process.
- The period of training for the individual trades will be 01 year. Candidates who have completed/ undergoing Apprentice Training, are not eligible.
- No TA/DA will be payable for attending the selection process. The candidates will have to make their own arrangement for stay during the selection.
- The reservations for engagement of Apprentice will be admissible as per Section 3A & B of apprentice Act 1961, Rule 5 of Apprenticeship Rules 1992 for SC/ST/OBC/EWS/ PWD/ XSM categories, as applicable. Copy of the reservation document is to be produced for verification.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Online Applications are invited for Apprenticeship Training (Technical Trade) at BRD, Air Force Station Chandigarh. Selection process for the same would be intimated later.
- Educational Qualification**
 - Passed Std 10th with minimum 50% marks. Std 12th pass is desirable.
 - ITI (NCVT) pass with 65% marks in aggregate.
